Adjust Your Pop-up Blocker Chrome and Explorer

- 3. Within the **"Privacy and Security"** click on **"Site Settings"**
- 4. Locate the "Pop-up and Redirects"
- There will be an option saying "Blocked (recommended)" and across from that a switch.
- 6. Make your adjustments

- 2. Click on the three little dots
- 3. Select the "Settings" option in the list.
- Click on the "Cookies & Site Permissions" and a box should appear on your screen.
- In the options there will be many tabs. Click on the "Pop-ups and Redirects" tab.
- 6. Adjust your "Pop-up Blocker" option settings.
- 7. Click "Apply" and then "Ok".
