How to Use this Resource:


1. Copy the code that is provided in the HTML column.
2. Go to the Canvas page you'd like to modify.
3. Click the Edit button and then Select the HTML EDITOR.
4. Paste the Code and make all the necessary modifications.



TIP#1: After pasting the code, switch to the **Rich Content Editor** to view the result of your code before saving.
