B. Ethnic Studies

The group discussed California's New Ethnic Studies Bill. V. Jacobi shared the requirements listed under the New Bill. Every campus is asked to review their current Ethnic Studies inventory & ensure they meet specific course objectives. Division with qualifying Ethnic Studies courses were encouraged to review & revise courses if necessary. The Bill expects all campuses to meet and implemented all standards by Fall 2021. The group will discuss new information as it becomes available.

C. C-ID Training/Textbook Adoption Request (TAR)

The Committee discussed the current Textbook Adoption Request (TAR) process. Courses with textbook updates are uploaded to our site before the start of every semester. Spring courses are updated during Winter Break, Fall courses are updated during the Summer. V. Jacobi encouraged Divisions to look on the C-ID website. There they can find resources to help with course revisions, New course proposals, and New Program proposal guides. This website will help Division ensure our course descriptions line up with States descriptors.
