DENTAL HYGIENE REMEDIATION COURSE STIPENDS

This Tentative Agreement ("Agreement") is made by and between the Taft College Faculty Association ("TCFA/CTA/NEA") and the West Kern Community College District ("District") (collectively referenced as the "parties") with respect to the following recitals:

As part of continuing dialogue through the Taft College Faculty Collective Bargaining Committee, the parties have reached a consensus regarding updating Dental Hygiene Remediation Course Stipends in the Faculty Collective Bargaining Agreement Salary Schedule, Appendix B-1, Page 2.

Now, therefore, TCFA/CTA/NEA and the District hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct.
- 2. The parties agree, effective January 1, 2019, the Human Resources Department will post an internal announcement whenever requested by the Director of Dental Hygiene for a qualified faculty or adjunct faculty member to conduct a 50 hour remediation course for The Dental Hygiene Board of California (DHBC) for a stipend of \$1200 per semester or an 80 hour remediation course for the Western Regional Exam Board (WREB) for a stipend of \$1500 per semester.
- 3. The parties further agree to update the Faculty Salary Schedule, Appendix B-1, Page 2 of the CBA as appropriate.
- 4. Except as set forth in this Agreement, all other terms and conditions of the CBA shall remain unchanged.
- 5. This Agreement will become effective after ratification by the TCFA/CTA/NEA members and the District's Governing Board.
