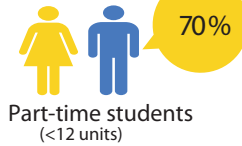
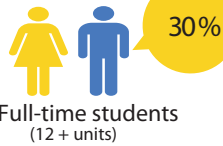

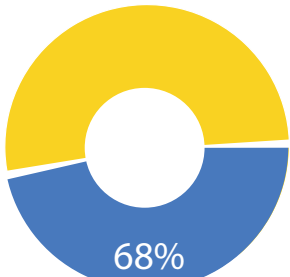

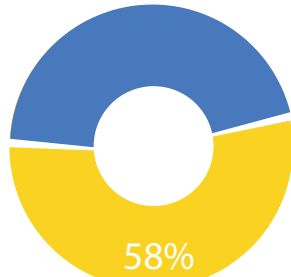
### STUDENT UNIT LOAD

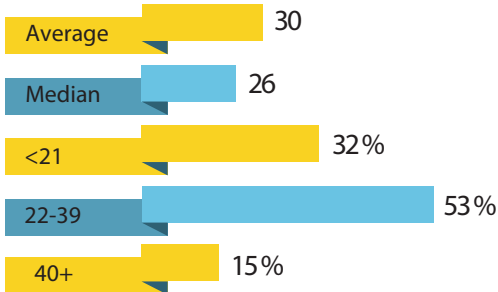

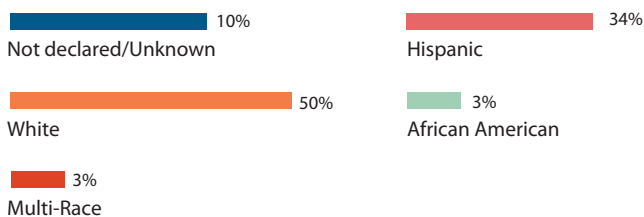
#### Age
