When in your course, go to the "Settings" tab and find "Grading Scheme"

What you need to know:

- ⇒ If you have this checkbox checked in any of your courses, the grading scale defaults to Canvas' grading scale which is incorrect for Taft College.
- ⇒ I cannot change the default settings. It is a Canvas setting.
- $\Rightarrow~$ Canvas' Default grade schemes count a 61% as an "F"
- ⇒ This feature is set at the course level. I cannot set them for everyone. They are controlled in each individual course.
- ⇒ You CAN use this feature, you just need to edit the grading scale to match that of Taft College.
