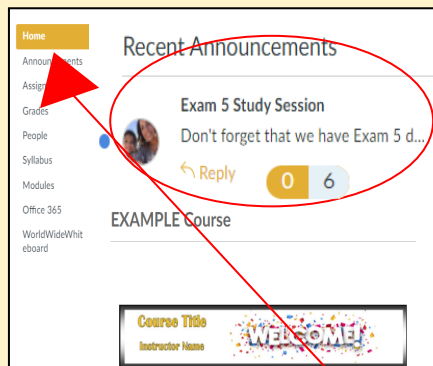


Engagement (cont.)- Think Outside the Box


Invite students to an out of the box way of studying for exams.

- ◆ Create a “Study Session” (name after exam/quiz) titled Announcement
- ◆ Allow responses and liking. Popular discussion threads move to the top
- ◆ Post guiding questions if activity is slow
- ◆ Encourage students with a few extra credit points for participation
- ◆ Let them know they can use this collaborative study session to study from up until the day of the quiz, or leave it open

- Respond to one of my questions.


