1. Select the Accessibility Icon. → 

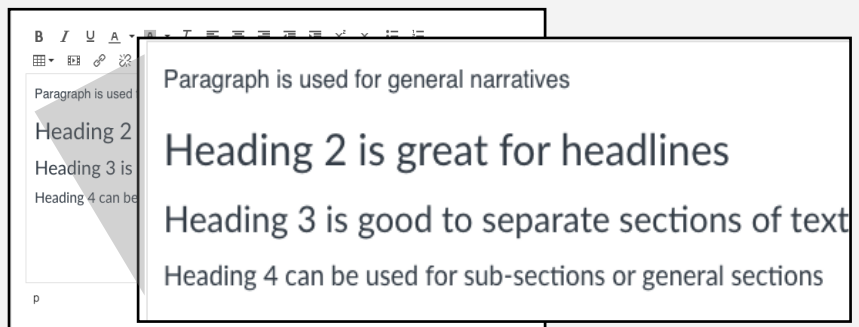
2. You will receive a message letting you know if your content has any accessibility issues.

ALT Text



When using pictures in your course shell, don't forget to add **ALT TEXT**. The alt text should be a description of the image so that all students who use screen readers can have an idea of what the image is.

TIPS

Grid/Tables



Try to stay away from the grid unless necessary. Screen Readers have a hard time translating the content in them. If you need tables, include a caption describing the content
