

Zoom– **Remove** Share Screen Ability for Attendees



If you would like to assure that you are the **ONLY** one that can share screen in Zoom meetings, Here's how to adjust those settings:

1. Login to [ConferZoom](#)
2. Select the “**Settings**” tab on the Left.
3. Select the “**IN Meeting Basic**”. option, under “meeting”.
4. Scroll down to the Screen sharing section.
5. For **Who Can Share**, select Host Only.
6. For **Who can start sharing** when someone else is sharing, select Host Only.
7. Under “**Annotation**”, turn this setting off (to gray.)

You can change these settings back on a day when you have students giving presentations who need to share their screens.
