Stimulus content gives students a reference or other items to read before answering the questions.

1. The **Title** will help you match it with the correct questions if you chose to **Save** it to the **Bank**.
2. Add **Instructions**. This could be as simple as “Read before answering the corresponding questions”
3. Enter any information you want to provide to the students in the **Content** Area. You can also embed a picture or video clip as well. (If you add a video please adjust your quiz time accordingly)
4. Add a **Source URL** for yourself. If you are adding a Video this would help to verify the video is still up and working. URLs are not visible to students.
5. Click **Add to Bank** to add the Stimulus to your Question Banks.
6. Click **Add Stimulus** to Save this Stimulus.
