

Creating a FlipGrid Assignment




Now that you have FlipGrid set up, we can create your first Assignment!

This will be done in Canvas

- 1. Start by going to your class where you just added FlipGrid.
- 2. Then go to your Assignments.
- 3. Add a new Assignment.
- 4. Enter your Title,
 Directions, Points, and
 Due Dates like normal. In
 the Submission Type
 change the Type to
 External Tool.
- 5. Click the **Find** button, then scroll down to FlipGrid.
- 6. Click on **FlipGrid** then click **Select**.
- 7. Don't forget to enter in your Attempts and Due Dates. Once you are done, click Save.


Now let's get editing with FlipGrid!




- 1. After Saving you should see a pop up about connecting a Flipgrid to Canvas. Click Create a Course Group.
- 2. The Title and instructions will pull from Canvas. If you did not create any instructions click on the **Pencil to edit.**
- 3. From here you can Edit the Title, Instructions\
 Prompt, Recording Time, and enable Video
 Moderation. Video
 Moderation hides videos until you have seen and approved them.
- 4. You can also Add Media to your instructions to help engage your students.
- 5. Under Topic Status you will want to set your Status to open. Also, set your open and close dates for the assignment.
