



**FlipGrid** is a tool that will let you create “grids” to help encourage student interaction and discussion. To view more about FlipGrids please watch this [Video on FlipGrids](#).

Below are the instructions you need to get started.

**NOTE:** Connect your FlipGrid to Canvas before developing grids or videos as any premade items will NOT carry over.

## Getting Started!

### Start in FlipGrid

1. Start by creating a [FlipGrid account](#). They are free!
2. When prompted, click on [Sign up with Microsoft](#). You will enter your TC email credentials.
3. Follow the prompts to set up your Profile.
4. You are now signed in. **Do not create any materials until you integrate it with Canvas!**
5. Click on the emoji (the top right corner).
6. You will see a drop down list. Click [Integrations](#).
7. Click on [Add New Integration](#) to link FlipGrid to Canvas.
8. Then Create a **Name** for this integration. This will create a new Grid and we recommend you name it after your class. [HIST 2231-40 FA20](#)
9. You will then get a Consumer Key and Shared Key. **Do not exit this screen** we will need it in a minute. Now we need to jump into Canvas.

## Add FlipGrid to Canvas!

1. Go to the class you want to use FlipGrid in. Then go to [settings](#).
2. Go to the tab [Apps](#), and search for [flipgrid](#). Then click on the icon for [Flipgrid](#).
3. Click on [Add App](#).
4. You will now be prompted for your **Consumer Key** and **Shared Secret** from [step 9 above](#). Copy and paste, then click [Add App](#).
5. You are now ready to create your first assignment!
