

Seeking alternative cloud storage for your Zoom recordings?

Alternative cloud storage options are available from several companies. We have provided different options below.

For Licensed accounts, Zoom provides free *temporary* housing of your videos (30 days/1 Gigabyte). However, do not rely on this storage space because you would not want to lose access to your prior or future videos. You will need to move your video content to an alternative *permanent* cloud storage.
