- Use Pope Tech when creating and editing digital content for your online students and consumers in Canvas.
- As part of the accessibility efforts run semesterly, monthly, or weekly scans with Pope Tech on all of your Canvas courses, pages, and resources.
- All videos should include captioning. Consider reviewing your videos to be reviewed annually. Talk with your DE staff for captioning tools.
