

AP 4102 Occupational/Vocational Technical Programs

Title 5 Sections 55600 et seq.

The competence of students completing vocational and occupational programs shall be evaluated by the same criteria that are used for all courses and in accordance with specific requirements established by the college for individual programs.

Advisory committees for occupational/vocational programs shall be established by the college within the Career and Technical Education area to assist in maintaining relevant curriculum, technology, equipment, course content, student internships and placement and to serve as liaison with local and regional employers and industry associations.

Members of advisory committees are appointed in accordance with processes established by the college and the Career and Technical Education area and should include appropriate program faculty, employers and employees in the field for which the program is designed to train students; former and current students; the Division Chair, and appropriate administrators.
