AP 4225 Course Repetition

Title 5 Sections 55761, 55762, 55763, 58161

Students may repeat courses designated as non-repeatable up to a total of two (2) times (third attempt) in which substandard grades (less than C) were awarded. Students must submit a Petition to Repeat form prior to enrolling in the course. Upon completion of a repeated course, subsequent to substandard coursework, the most recent evaluative grade earned will be computed in the cumulative grade-point average and the student's academic record so annotated.

Students may repeat a course for which substandard work has not been recorded if the college has determined that a student should repeat a course based on finding that circumstances exist which justifies such repetition. The grade, units, and grade points of the second attempt of the course will not be used for the computation of the cumulative grade point average in determining academic status.

Repeatable courses, variable unit courses, general/occupational work experience, and course taken by students with disabilities may be exempt from the course repetition policy.
