

AP 4228 Course Repetition – Significant Lapse of Time

Title 5 Section 55043

Students may be permitted or required to repeat courses in which a 'C' or better grade was earned where there was a significant lapse of time since the grade was obtained and the college has determined that a student should repeat a course based on finding that circumstances exist which justify such repetition. The grade, units, and grade points of the second attempt of the course will not be used for the computation of the cumulative grade point average in determining academic status.

Activity courses and other repeatable courses, variable unit courses, general/occupational work experience, and students with disabilities may be exempt from the course repetition policy. The college catalog lists reasonable reasons to repeat a course. Petitions to repeat a course for which substandard work has not been recoded are available in the Counseling Center or on the college website.
