West Kern Community College District Annual Financial Report, June 30, 2015

#### Background:

Under *California Code of Regulations (CCR)*, title 5, section 59102, the governing board of each California Community College district is required to provide for an annual audit. Arrangements for annual audits for any fiscal year are defined by the requirements listed in Section 84040 of the *Education code*. Section 84040.5 of the *Education Code* requires the Board of Governors and the Department of Finance to prescribe the statements and other information to be included in the audit report filed with the state and to develop audit procedures for carrying out these audits. The audit must therefore be conducted in accordance with Section 84040.5 of the *Education Code*. Each audit examination shall include all funds and account groups of the district, including the general fund, student financial aid funds or other federal grant funds, student body funds, cafeteria funds, debt service funds, and any other funds under the control or jurisdiction of the district to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement.

The District engaged the services of Vavrinek, Trine, Day & Co., LLP (VTD) to perform the independent audit services for the year ended June 30, 2015. VTD has performed audit services for the District in the past for the fiscal years ending 2007-2011, 2013, and 2014.

As with prior years, the annual financial report shows the District is in full compliance with all standards for the 2014/2015 fiscal year. An unqualified opinion is included with the financial report. The report has been submitted to the California Community Colleges Chancellor's office as required by the *Education Code*.
