Topic: Exporting Word Documents to PDF

Why It Is Important: Adobe Reader is a free PDF reader, thus making PDF formatted documents accessible to all users

How to Do It: To export to PDF:

- Mark up your Word documents for accessibility features (e.g., headings, alt text, etc.)
 Acrobat PDFMaker
- 2) Click on Acrobat tab and select Preferences
- 3) Make sure that these checkboxes are checked:
- Create Bookmarks
- Enable Accessibility and Reflow with tagged Adobe PDF
- 5) Click Create PDF
- 6) Open PDF file and check for possible errors

Specific Learning Disability

A disorder of one or more of the basic psychological processes involved in understanding or in using language, spoken or written, which may manifest itself in difficulties listening, thinking, speaking, reading, writing, spelling, or doing mathematical calculations. Limitations may include hyperactivity, distractibility, emotional instability, visual and/or auditory perception difficulties and/or motor limitations, depending on the type(s) of learning disability.
