Topic: Using "Reader" Firefox Add-On to De-Clutter Webpage and Gain Cleaner Reading Environment
Why It Is Important: Many webpages contain distracting information and images that can slow down students' reading experience
How to Do It: To Use "Reader" Add-On:
1) Launch Firefox browser > Go to: https://addons.mozilla.org > enter "Reader" in search box > click on "Add to Firefox"
2) When encountering a page with lots of extraneous info, click the Reader icon and wait for window to adjust.
3) Scroll down in the window and read without clutter!

NOTE: By clicking on the down arrow next to the Reader icon, you can also:

- Change the font type, size, type, style, and color of the reader
- Adjust the background color
- Determine the width of the box
- Alter the color of the links

To revert to the original formatting of your webpage, simply click on the Refresh button
