

# Internship Qualifications & Screening Process

#### **GETTING STARTED:**

- ✓ Complete and submit Internship Interest Form online at TC Career Center
- ✓ TC Career Center will review your eligibility and be in contact via email.
- ✓ If eligible, student is to call and schedule appointment with Career Counselor to discuss minimum qualifications and begin screening process.

## **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- Active Student\*
- Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 or above\*
- Rating of at least 3 in all areas of the Faculty Student Evaluation Survey\*

#### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Completion of core program courses as identified and recommended by industry and faculty\*
- Completion of internship screening process\*

\*Subject to change. Multiple-measures can be used to determine candidacy.

### **SCREENING PROCESS**

## **Orientation**

- Explain general internship participation expectations and student responsibilities
- Discuss student career and educational goals-- what is student looking for in an internship?
- If applicable, discuss currently available internship details position, location, wages

# Resume Building

- Coaching on how to develop and tailor resume
- Create College Central Network account and upload resume

# **Interview Skills**

- Coaching on interviewing techniques (STAR)
- Mock interview

#### **NEXT STEPS:**

Students who <u>are</u> eligible and meet minimum qualifications, will be added to the available interns list and will be notified via email of all internship opportunities, including application and selection procedures.

Students who <u>are not</u> eligible and/or do not meet minimum qualifications will be informed of what is needed and expected and provided the opportunity to create an action plan and work with a counselor to become eligible.
